- 3. What is a brief life story about them?**
- 4. What is their educational background? Where did they study?**
- 5. Where did they work? Was it a university or a clinic/hospital?**
- 6. What are they known for?**
- 7. What are their theories or ideas? Explain them.**
- 8. Any other interesting information about them?**
